Series B cards are smaller and require less memory.

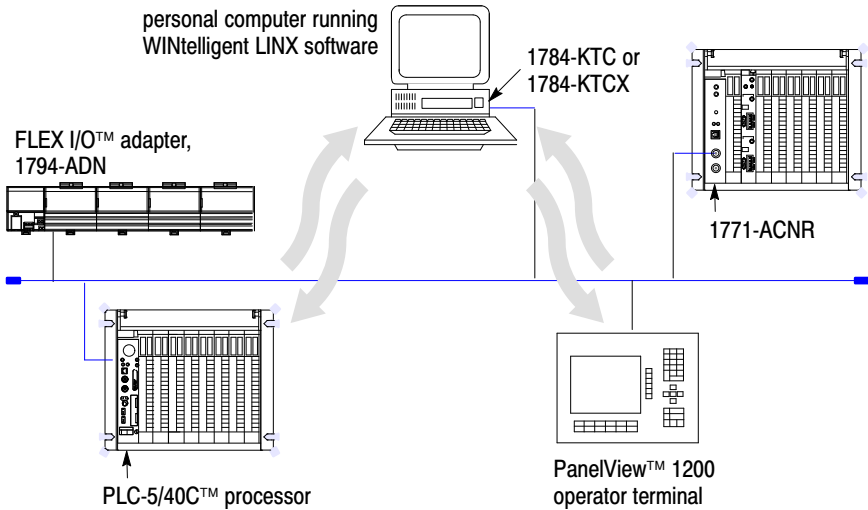

WINTelligent LINX Gateway lets you bridge messages between ControlNet and any other WINTelligent LINX driver, e.g., DH+™, DH485, and Ethernet®.

Important: You must also have series C, revision K of 1785-L20C or 1785-L40C, or series D, revision B of 1785-L20C, 1785-L40C, 1785-L60C, or 1785-L80C.

Unsolicited Messaging: The 1784-KTC and 1784-KTCX can now receive unsolicited messages, making them capable of two-way communication.
